1. Personal pronouns:  I, you, he, she, it, we, you, they

Singular

Plural

- I am 10 years old.
- This is Lisa. She is a girl.
- This is our house. It is white and big.
- Tom is a boy. He is a good football player.
- There are some girls. They are at the music centre.
- Wow, boys! You are really good at Tennis!
- Hi Tom! You are in my English class.
- Sue is not at home. She is at school.
- This is Kelly's dog. It is a nice dog.
- The kids are in the garden. They are playing Frisbee.
- Mrs Brown is our neighbour. She is very old.
- Can you help me, please?

2. The verb "to be" :  am, are, is

am =

- I am good at Maths but I 'm not good at English.
- I like barbies. They are wonderful.
- We are class 5g. We are at Liebfrauenhaus.
- The boys are at the football stadium.
- Peter and I are in Mrs Jeschar's English class.
- Paul is a boy. He is 11 years old.
- Sally is not at home. She and her friends are shopping.
- The cat is really nice. Her name is Blacky.
- Mr X is a good rapper. He and his friends are good musicians.  
(=they)
- "You are my best friend, Katie."
- I am from Herzogenaurach. Zoe is from Erlangen.
