| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ you need it to get from Manhattan to Brooklyn ➤ crosses the East River ➤ building began in 1867 and was finished in 1883 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ It is one of the first things that people see when they arrive in New York ➤ It was a present given by France to the USA ➤ It is 102 metres high | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ There are lots of cars, adverts, stores and people ➤ Before the 20th century horses were sold there ➤ MTV`s headquarters is there |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Between 1892 and 1954 about 12 million people came to this place to immigrate to the USA ➤ It was also called the „Isle of Tears“ ➤ named after Samuel Ellis | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 102 floors high ➤ for a long time the highest building in the world ➤ On a clear day you can see for 80 miles from the 86th floor | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 337 ha big ➤ You can play baseball and frisbee there ➤ There is a zoo too ➤ Many people spend their free time there |
| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Belongs to all nations represented in ➤ In front of the building there are the flags of all member nations ➤ A tour through the building is offered in 20 different languages | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ has room for 200 people ➤ 100 meters high ➤ The bishop of New York has an office there | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ There is a big open place which is 89,000 m² ➤ 19 buildings inside the center ➤ You can go ice skating there in winter |
