will-future

Mit dem *will-future* kannst du Voraussagen machen und Vermutungen anstellen, z. B. bei Wettervorhersagen oder Horoskopen.

Beispiele:

Tomorrow it will be rainy in Germany.
You will have a job next year.

Du kannst es auch verwenden, um spontane Entschlüsse auszudrücken.

Beispiele:

You're hurt? I will come and help you.
It's raining? I will stay at home.

Du gebrauchst das *will-future* auch, um zukünftige Ereignisse zu beschreiben, auf die du keinen Einfluss hast.

Beispiele:

The summer holidays will be in July. I will be thirteen then.

Für die Bildung des *will-future* gibt es ein einfaches Muster:

will + Grundform des Verbs (Infinitiv)

Beim Sprechen benutzt du die Kurzform mit **'ll** in bejahten und **won't** (= *will not*) in verneinten Aussagen.

Beispiele:

I'm sure she'll miss the train. She won't be at the station in time.
